## **Kanabec County**

We have not begun construction on either project area yet so I would wait to publish this until we are closer to the finish line, most likely this fall. However, if you have any questions please let me know.

Mora Municipal Utilities is in the process of installing electric vehicle (EV) charging stations. There will be two chargers, for a total of four charging ports, installed downtown Mora by the Klocka. These chargers will be the Level 2 Chargers which will take about 45 mins.-1.5 hours to fully charge a vehicle.

There will also be one DC Fast Charger, for a total of two charging ports, at Coborns. These will take approximately 30 mins. to fully charge a vehicle. We are still working through the legal agreements for this site and I don't foresee issues with that as many municipal utilities are working with Coborns on EV charging stations.
