#2: Sharing non-5310 funded vehicles: UTILIZE VEHICLES OWNED BY ORGANIZATIONS/BUSINESSES/INDIVIDUALS

Stakeholder and Community Engagement:

GOAL: To use mobility management for cultivating partnerships, creating or joining collaborative efforts that include transportation providers, planners, and other community stakeholders

PROBLEM STATEMENT: Need for engagement among stakeholders and community for identifying and addressing transportation issues and options involving public entities, private for profit and non-profit organizations, employers, transit, advocates and others

Mobility Management Integration:

GOAL: To use mobility management skills and process for new, emerging local , regional and statewide issues

PROBLEM STATEMENT: Identifying and addressing interrelated issues impacting transportation access/collaboration such as climate/environmental changes, emergency/disaster preparation, DEI- (diversity, equity, inclusion), land use planning, strategic planning initiatives with OTAT- (Office of Transit and Active Transportation), and other initiatives

PROBLEM STATEMENT: Need to collaborate with MCOTA Members as a Work Team participant by actively addressing barriers which impede transportation access*


